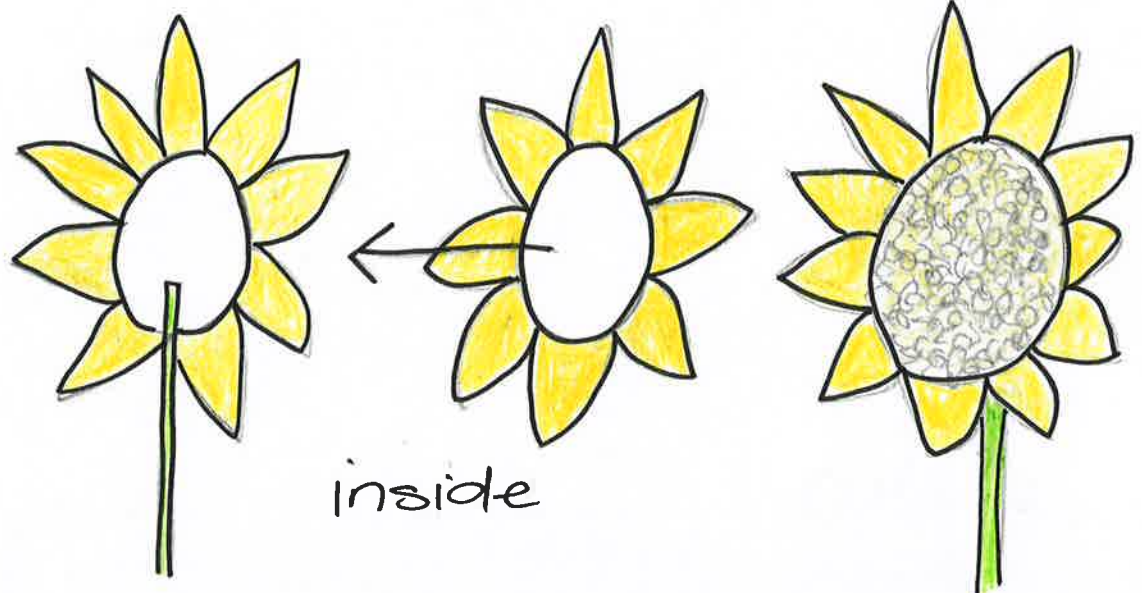


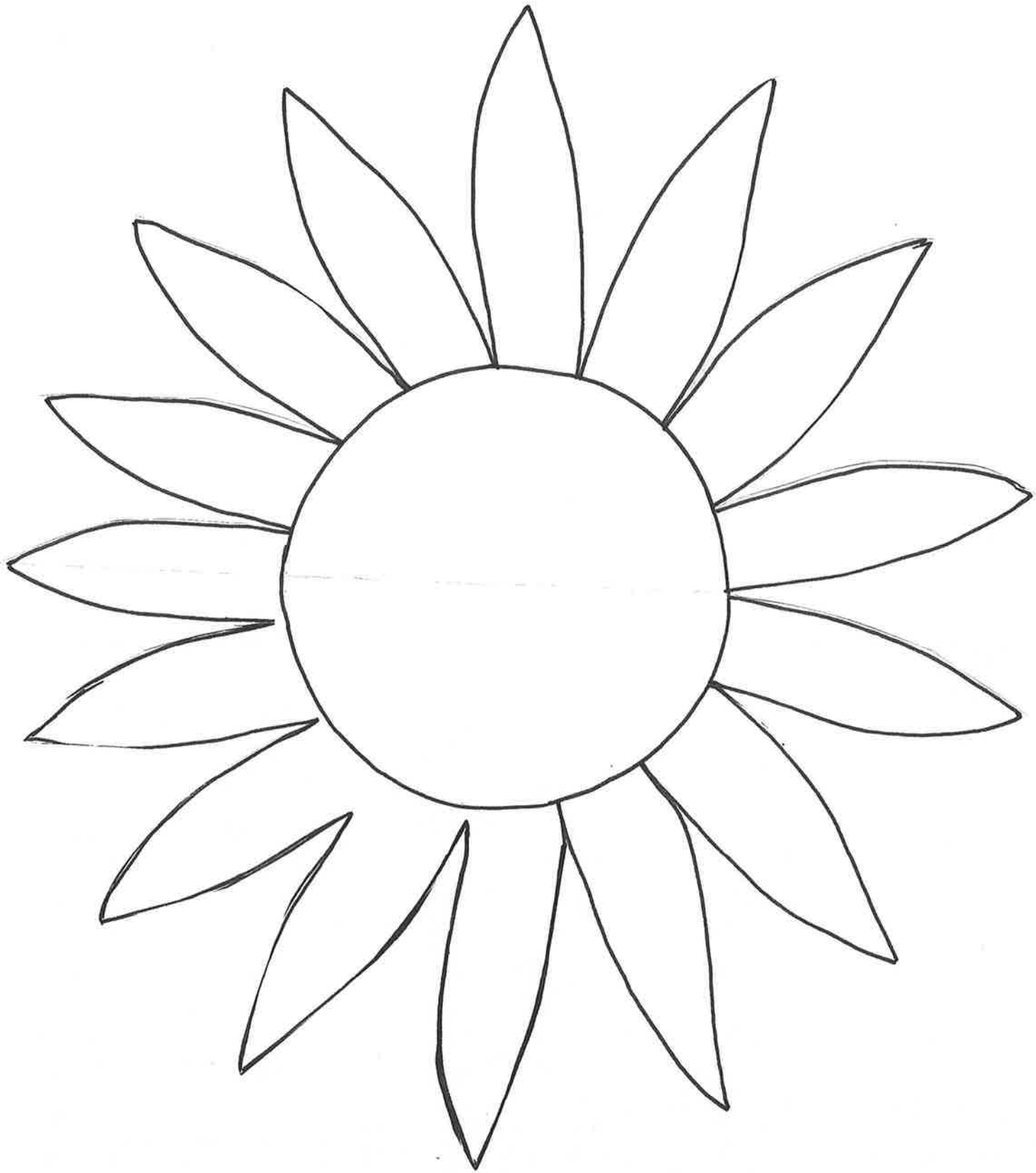
1. Sunflower easy colouring with pencils and bees to copy or stick.
2. Sunflower advanced colouring with pencils with drawing techniques sheet
3. Sunflowers for small vases or displays. For this activity you need a small piece of garden cane painted green or roll an A4 piece of card lengthways painted green to make a stem. Copy the sunflower template onto card x2. Cut each template out. Colour each petal both sides of each template. Can use felt pens for this.

For the centre of the sunflower cut up small pieces of tissue about 2 cms - can use ordinary tissues. Scrunch each piece and stick to the centre of the sunflower.

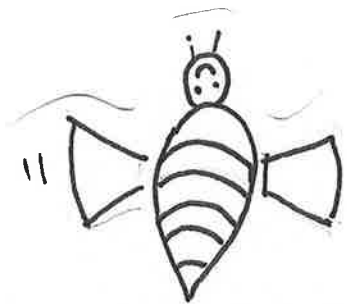
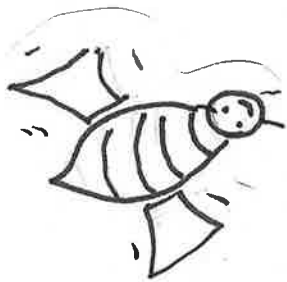
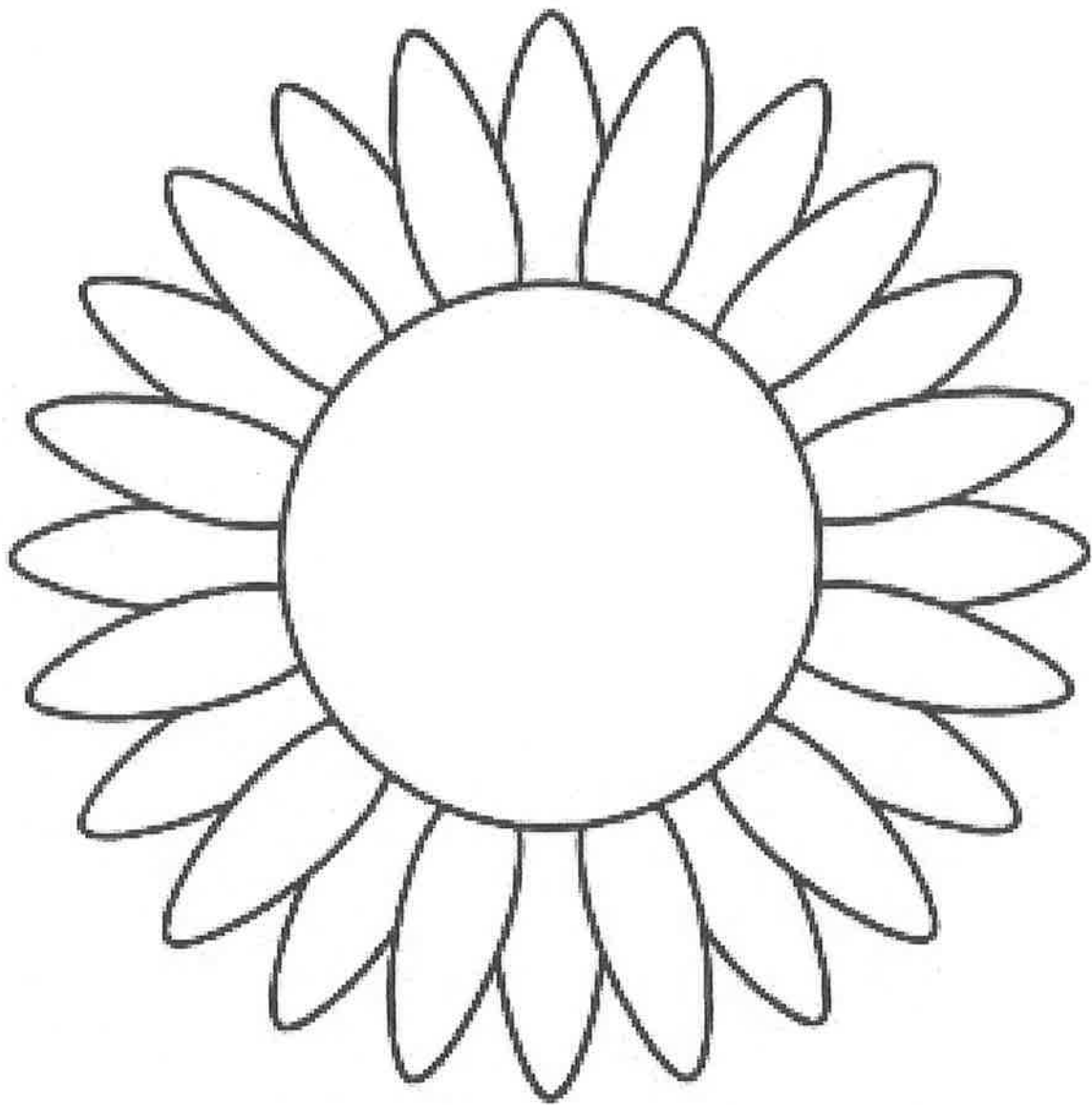
When dry, leave white or carefully go over tissue with a felt pen.

Place both finished sunflowers together one on top of each other. When in position insert cane and glue both sunflower centres together with cane in between. Leave to dry.



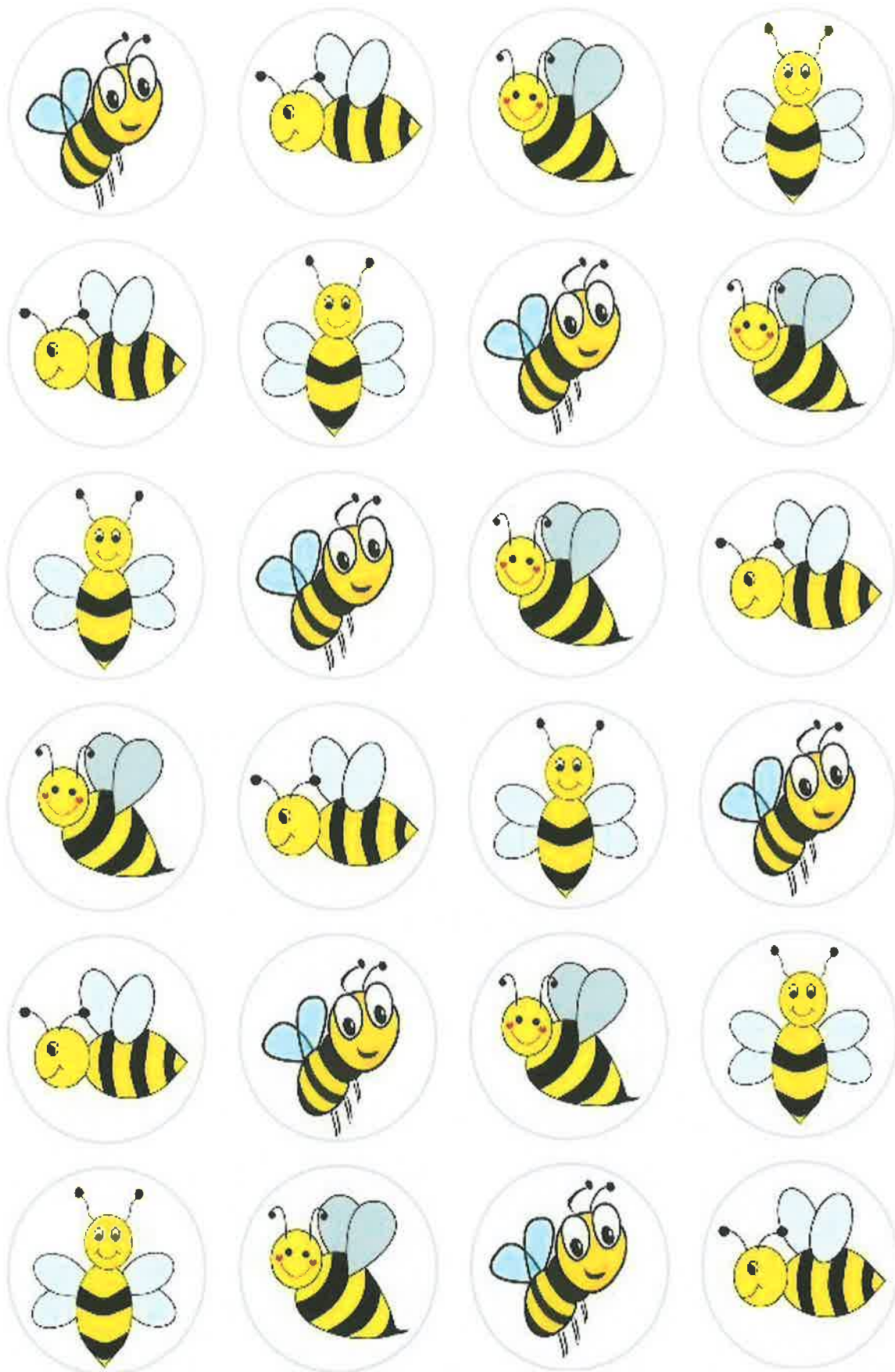


template for 3d sunflower

Drawing Techniques for Sunflower Activity Advanced Adding Tone

Tone is shading and gives objects a solid form. To give the sunflower a feeling of being true to life shade can be added.

Simple Shading

Shade can be made by pressing harder with the pencil on the paper.



Light Shading



Dark Shading



Darker Shading

Shading can be made by using the pencil in a different way.

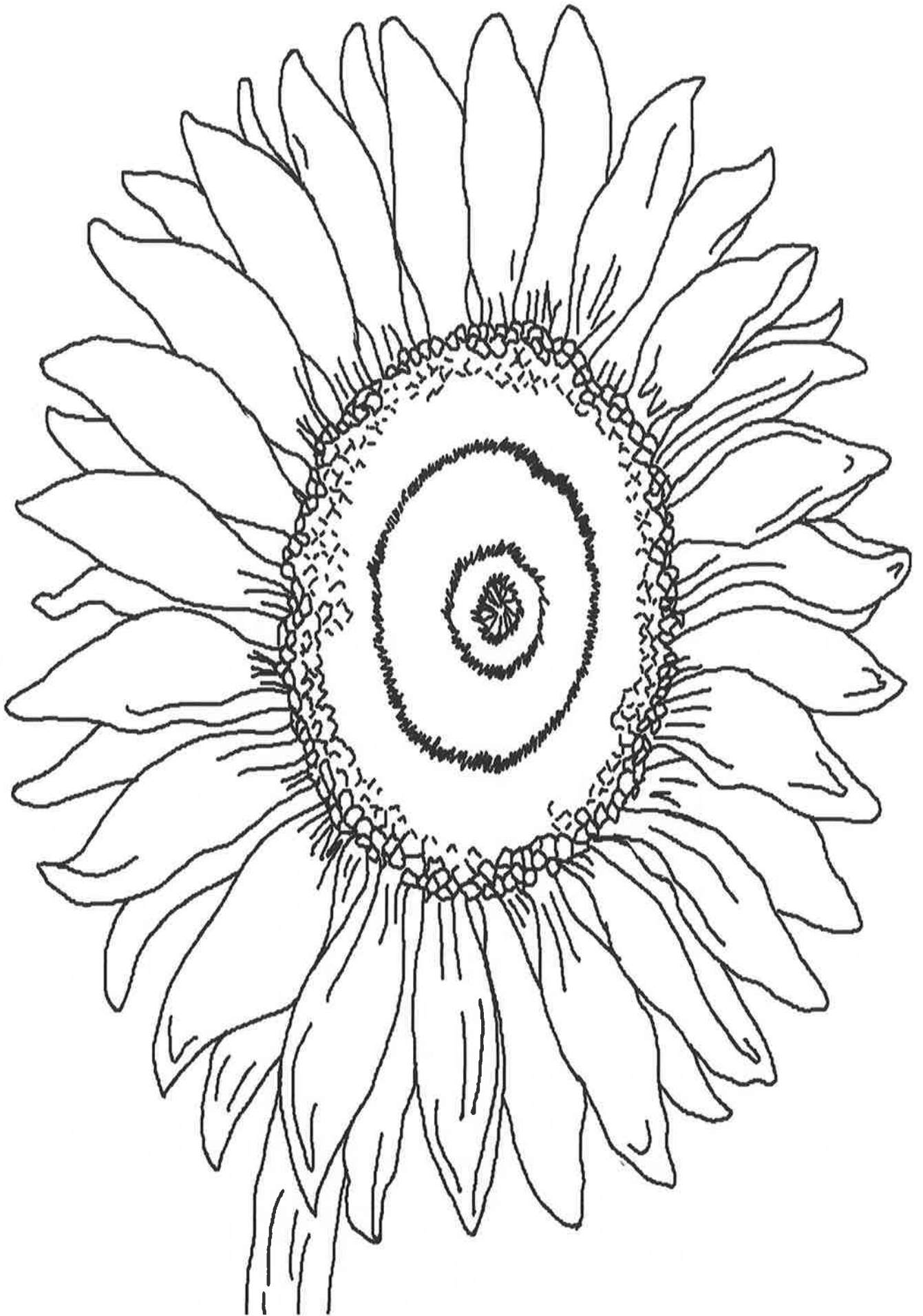


Shading Using Hatching
