

WILLY WONKA'S SWEETS EXPERIMENT



EXPERIMENT 1:

Place some Skittles on a plate in a circle, add a little water and watch the colours leave the sweets and make a wonderful rainbow on the plate. Which works best hot or cold water?



EXPERIMENT 2:

Can you see the 'S' float on the water? The 'S' should separate from the skittle as the outer coating starts to break down.

Can you find any other sweets this works with? How about M&M's?

FROBSCOTTLE

Ingredients

8 Kiwi fruits peeled

Juice from 1 1/2 limes

8 fl oz (200ml) lemonade

4 fl oz (100ml) raspberry drinking yoghurt

12 fl oz (300ml) cream soda

- Liquidise the kiwis & lime juice in a food processor
- Push the pulp through a sieve into a large jug
- Add the drinking yoghurt and mix
- Gradually mix in the lemonade
- Finally pour in the cream soda and mix



SNOZZCUMBER SANDWICHES

Ingredients

1 ridged cucumber

6 slices rye bread, halved

170g herby cream cheese




6 small gherkins, sliced

2tbsp poppy seeds



Drag the handle of a teaspoon down the edges of the cucumber to create grooves down the whole length. Slice and remove the central seeds with an apple corer. Spread each piece of bread with a little cream cheese. Tip the remaining cheese into a small bowl and mix with the sliced gherkins. Spoon this topping onto each cucumber slice and sprinkle with poppy seeds to serve.

MAKE A BFG DREAM CATCHER JAR



WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- MASON JARS
- GLITTER
- TISSUE PAPER
- GLOW BRACELETS
- PEN
- STICKER LABELS
- GLOW-IN-THE-DARK PAINT
- PAINTERUSH

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1 Sprinkle glitter inside mason jar. Shake gently.
- 2 Tear a piece of tissue paper to match the size of your mason jar. Crinkle for texture and line the inside of the jar.
- 3 Bend and shake glow bracelets in many places to activate glowing. Fold into bracelet shape and place three inside jar.
- 4 Coat label sticker with glow-in-the-dark paint. Let dry.
- 5 Tear and crinkle label sticker to create an aged effect.
- 6 Write the title of your dream on the label and place on the side of the jar.

You will need: Coloured paper, crepe paper, tissue paper, scissors, pencil, glue, string, 2 paper plates




- Use coloured paper and crepe paper to cut out a neck and head, beak, wings, legs and feet, eyes

Glue them onto the edge of the plate and tail



- Glue another plate on





- Rip up pieces of tissue paper and glue them on the plate like feathers
- Snip the ends of the tail and twist the paper to look like feathers



- Tie a piece of string to the top of the bird for hanging
